**ENGINEERING FOR KIDS – AGES 4 – 6 – Workshop # 4 and # 5**

We are happy to offer our students the opportunity to participate in these very exciting programs. Engineering for Kids are workshops that bring science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM), to kids in a fun and challenging way.

These classes will be for 6 weeks – July 11 – August 15.

**“Jr. Robotics – Adventure Stories” #4** - 9:30 – 10:30: The Junior Robotics class is the perfect mixture of fun and learning while using Lego bricks. Students build an airplane for rescue, a sailboat to escape a storm, and more. They also learn how to program and operate their creations using a laptop computer.

**“Jr. Aerospace Engineering – Taking to the Skies” #5** - 10:45 – 11:45: This class introduces our youngest engineers to fundamental concepts of aircraft and spacecraft design. Through open and focused exploration, students investigate and construct airplanes, rockets, hot air balloons and more.

**ENGINEERING FOR KIDS – AGES 7 – 12 – Workshop # 6 and # 7**

**“Robotic Olympics” # 6** – 9:00 - 10:30: During the Lego Robotics Olympics camp, students design and program robots to compete in simulated Olympic events such as sprinting in a race, throwing a basketball, and shooting a puck into a hockey goal. Students use Lego Robotics and computers to learn principles of robotics, computer programming, and teamwork.

**“Engineering Olympiad” #7** - 10:45 – 12:15– Who has the strength to be a world-class athlete? In this program, students will separate into teams in various tests of mental and creative strength. The students will earn medals throughout the class and strive to become the next great Engineering Olympiad! These classes are also for 6 weeks –July 11 – August 15.

We, on behalf of ourselves and our child, hereby release and discharge Montessori Children’s Center of Allen Park, Inc., its agents, employees and officers from all claims, demands, actions or judgments which the undersigned ever had, now has or may have in the future against the school, Montessori Children’s Center of Allen Park, Inc. its successors or assigns, for all personal injuries or illnesses, which the child named above may suffer or incur as a result of the actions of the Montessori Children’s Center of Allen Park, Inc. in administering or failure to administer medicine, administering or failing to administer first aid, or procuring medical treatment if all reasonable attempts to reach us are unsuccessful.

We certify that the child named above is in good health and free from any communicable disease or illness.

PAYMENT AGREEMENT: We understand that children are enrolled for complete weeks, and that our agreement to pay charges for each full week is not subject to adjustments because of illness, absence or acts of nature. We agree to pay, when applicable, other fees as out lined in the Parent Handbook. These may include registration, hourly day care, or NSF fees, late pick up charges, or an occasional field trip. We understand that our child may be denied admission to camp and/or workshops if tuition or fees are not paid in a timely manner. **ADMISSION FORM MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY REQUIRED FEES:**

For Day Camp: \$25.00 non-refundable registration fee.

All workshop course and material fees are nonrefundable.

◆ **STAFF** ◆

A professional staff led by our certified elementary teachers and Montessori trained preschool directresses will guide & direct this year's camper.

◆ **APPLICATION and FEES** ◆

A \$25.00, non-refundable, application fee is required for all children at the time of enrollment.

A minimum of three weeks enrollment is required but do not need to be consecutive.

No refunds of camp or workshop charges will be given unless another student fills the space. Any refund will be prorated, based upon the alternate student's start date.

- Extended day session: Both AM **and** PM (7:00 a.m. – 5:45 p.m.) \*\$175.00 per week

Deduct \$10.00 from camp fee for each week that your child is attending **both** camp and a workshop during the same week. There is a one time, \$10.00 reduction per workshop.

**Workshop, & material fees are payable, in full, at the time of enrollment and are non-refundable, except in the event the class is full or cancelled. Please make a first and second choice for the time you would like tutoring or piano. However, time will not be guaranteed until payment has been received. Piano and tutoring times are "first come, first serve". You may be contacted to discuss alternate times or classes.** Most workshops are Monday through Thursday.

All children should bring a morning snack. Students staying past 11:30 a.m. should also bring a lunch. Preschool, kindergarten and PM latch key students may also bring an afternoon snack. Milk and water are provided.

Friday's will once again be our "picnic on the playground" day. Each Friday, weather permitting, we will cook hot dogs and enjoy a long lunch hour with water play and games.
